"Thy will be done" is the third of the seven petitions in the Lord's prayer and is the bible verse that keeps Meghan Poole motivated and reminds her that God will take care of it all during life's journey. Meghan and her five year old daughter Myah currently live in temporary housing that is extremely overcrowded, resulting in a single room being their only living space.

A graduate from Southeastern University, Meghan currently works at Chick-fil-A as a Team Leader. She has tried to search for better living options for her and her daughter, but could not find affordable housing that could make the change possible. By partnering with Habitat for Humanity St. Tammany West (STW) Meghan will be able to purchase a decent home with an affordable mortgage after completing 300 sweat equity hours.

"I've never had my own place that was just mine. To me, home is a safe place where I can be myself and not have to worry about others. I want my daughter to have a home that she can call her own" said Meghan. "A place where we can play outside and do all the fun things we like to do like cuddle, and watch movies."

The Poole Family home will be funded by the proceeds of the Habitat for Humanity St. Tammany West ReStore. Habitat for Humanity ReStores are home improvement stores and donation centers that sell new and gently used furniture, appliances, home accessories, and more to the public at a fraction of the retail price. The money raised through the Habitat STW ReStore helps to ensure that everyone in our community has a decent and affordable place to call home. We are very thankful for our donors, shoppers and volunteers who have helped families in our community realize their dream of homeownership.
